

## **Tavistock Farms Pool Rules and Guidelines Covid-19 Addendum (2021)**

1. Residents should sign up for pool passes by downloading the new MokoApp (preferred), via the MokoApp website or via paper application at the pool house, if needed.
2. Residents must agree to the "Hold Harmless" Covid-19 Agreement on file to be issued a pool pass.
3. Pool occupancy will initially be limited to 75%, per VA executive order 72 (~95 people). If occupancy is reached, lifeguards will post notifications and no additional residents will be admitted.
4. Residents will be required to provide attestation at pool entrance acknowledging lack of Covid-19 primary symptoms/conditions.
5. Residents should adhere to Covid-19 guidelines as outlined via signage at the pool, including social distancing requirements and mask wearing when inside Tavistock facilities (pool house & bathrooms). Residents not adhering to rules will be asked to leave the pool by lifeguards.
6. Residents will follow outlined one-way traffic flow entering and exiting the pool deck
7. Residents should bring their own chairs, if desired, and be spaced 6 feet from non-family members, per executive order 72. Tavistock Farms owned pool furniture will not be provided on deck.
8. Residents will vacate the Tavistock Farms pool facility periodically for Covid-19 cleaning. Scheduled cleaning times will be posted in the pool house, but it may be necessary to close as needed.
9. Parties and large gatherings will not be permitted at the pool. Exceptions include swim team ODSL regulated events.
10. Residents are discouraged from bringing food to the pool, as there are no tables at this time. Food deliveries are also prohibited at this time.
11. Guests will be limited to 2 per household, but residents may have additional guests pre-approved through PMP for a limited period of time.
